Aviation Maintenance CD User Guide

This CD contains a high quality reproduction of an original factory manual in the popular PDF Format (Portable Document Format). It also contains version 4.05 of the Adobe® Acrobat® Reader™. The Acrobat Reader is required to view the manual(s).

System Requirements

The minimum computer system configuration for running this CD:

Windows 95/98, 486 processor, 16 MB RAM, and 4X CD-ROM Drive.

The recommended minimum computer system configuration for running this CD:

Windows 95/98/2000/ME/NT 4.0 (SP 3), 200 Mhz processor, 32 MB RAM, and 24X CD-ROM Drive.

Installation Instructions

The service manual files on this CD are in Adobe PDF (portable document format). If the Adobe Acrobat Reader is already installed on your computer then *no* installation is required. This CD is designed as an 'Autoplay' CD. It should execute automatically after being loaded into your computer's CD-ROM drive. If it doesn't, then autoplay may have been disabled on your computer. In that case, follow these steps to run the CD;

1. Click on the Start button in the lower left corner of your desktop.
2. Select Run.
3. Type 'X:\autorun.exe'
(Replace X with the letter designation of your CD-ROM drive)
4. Click the OK button

Using the CD

There are 3 primary selection types on the opening title screen. To activate a selection, just put the mouse pointer on the desired selection and click the left mouse button.

1. View/open the manual - selecting this will open a manual for viewing (or printing). If this doesn't happen, the likely cause is that Adobe Acrobat Reader is not currently installed on your computer. To confirm whether or not Adobe Acrobat is installed on your computer, click on 'Start', 'Programs', and look for Adobe Acrobat in your program list.

2. Visit the MTG Website – This will connect you to our home page on the Internet (assuming you have an Internet connection). Our address on the web is www.mccurtainTG.com.

3. Install Adobe Acrobat Reader 4.05

Select this option if Adobe Acrobat Reader is *not* currently installed on your computer, or if you want to upgrade from a prior version of Acrobat Reader. If you have an earlier version of Acrobat Reader installed on your computer and you want to upgrade to 4.05, first uninstall the existing version and then restart your computer before installing version 4.05. You can also get the latest version and support for Adobe Acrobat Reader at Adobe's Website, www.adobe.com. For best results, we recommend using version 4.05, or later, rather than an earlier version of Adobe Acrobat Reader.

To exit from the CD, click on the close button (X) in the upper right corner of the opening title screen.

To exit from the manual or our from Website, click on the close button (X) in the upper right corner of the window. This will return you to the opening title screen.

To exit from the Help Page, click on the close button (X) in the upper right corner of the window. This will return you to the opening title screen.

Printing in Adobe Acrobat

When printing PDF document pages, the print confirmation screen will offer the option of printing all pages, the current page or a range of pages. The default is all pages so be sure to specify the correct option at print time. The option "**Print as image**" should be selected. There is also an option for printing Annotations. This option should be selected. Some of our products contain revisions made as Annotations. They will not show up on printed pages if the Annotations option is turned off at print time.

ADOBE ACROBAT READER – Setting GENERAL PREFERENCES

Our software products have been designed to work properly with specific settings in Adobe Acrobat Reader General Preferences. Below is information for confirming the proper settings in Acrobat Reader version 4.05.

The settings given below are all default settings (except item 4) so unless these values were changed after Adobe Acrobat was installed on your computer; you should not have to change anything except for item number 4. To confirm your settings, open Adobe Acrobat Reader and click on *FILE, PREFERENCES, and GENERAL*.

1. "Smooth Text and Images" should be selected (checkmark).
2. "Display Large Images" should be selected (checkmark).
3. "Use Logical Page Numbers" should be selected (checkmark).
4. "Open Cross-Doc Links in the Same Window" should NOT be selected (no checkmark).

Click "OK" to save your settings and close the General Preferences window.
